## CARDBOARD AND DUCT TAPE BOAT BUILDING COMPETITION August 5, 2023

### THERE ARE 3 AGE DIVISIONS IN THE FINALS

7 years and under

8-12 years

13-17 years

18 years and over

### OFFICIAL RULES

- ONE captain per boat
- Cardboard and duct tape only
- Cardboard must start as a flat corrugated (cardboard box) type of cardboard
- Use of sonotubes or other specialty cardboards are not allowed (30 second penalty)
- The use of plastic, bubble wrap, styrofoam, paint or any other material is not allowed
- ***Boats in all age groups cannot be built in a surfboard fashion.*** Boats must be built with sides so that the captain sits in the boat.
- All boats must be constructed prior to race time using ONLY DUCT TAPE AND CARDBOARD!

### ROUND 2 - FINALS

The top three times of the 8-12 years group, the 13-17 years and the 18 years and older group will qualify for the finals to be held in the pool area during our Pirate Pool Party that evening. The nine captains will be given identical “Cardboard Boat Kits” provided by the Lone Oak Recreation Dept. With these kits, they will each build a boat to compete for the top trophy. Boats may be powered by hands only, no oars or paddles. One captain per boat.
