Lone Oak Campsites was established in 1964 by Abraham "Bucky" and Rosalie Brown. The property, now known as Lone Oak Campsites, has been in the Brown family for over 90 years. Bucky bought the land for farming purposes in 1955 from his father.

The idea of building a campground came from a magazine article describing how farmers were developing some of their land as campsites for extra income. Soon tractor routes through pasture lands became camp roads to small clusters of custom-made sites. Thus, Lone Oak Farm became Lone Oak Campsites.

Pool & Hot Tub

We have two pools and one hot tub located behind the Office building. Guests can access them from the front of the Office building near the restrooms or from inside the Rec Hall. The pool area opens Memorial Day weekend and, weather permitting, will remain open past Labor Day weekend.

Children under 14 years are not allowed in the pool area without a parent or guardian. You must be 18 years or older to watch over a sibling (under 14yrs) in the pool. Pool and hot tub hours are posted at the pool entrance and listed on the recreation schedule. The pool area hours are subject to weather conditions. The pool rules are posted by the pool entrance and the pump house.

Those 16 years and older are allowed in the hot tub. Due to increased heart rate from heat, it is unsafe for children. No one under the age of 16 will be allowed in the hot tub.

The pools are heated to 80°F and the hot tub is heated to 100°F. The small pool's depth range is 2.5 feet - 5.0 feet; the large pool's depth range is 3.0 feet - 5.0 feet.

Periodically, we offer pool games and programs such as "adult swim." These programs allow children to play various games in one pool and adults to enjoy the other pool for one hour without any children. These programs are listed on the rec schedule and announced in advance on the campground PA system.

Chipmunk Market

The Chipmunk Market is located across from the Office and offers a wide selection of merchandise: everything from toothbrushes to RV-safe toilet paper. There are a variety of toys for the children, camping equipment, and parts for repair. We also carry Lone Oak clothing and souvenirs.

Hayloft Lounge

The Hayloft Lounge is located above the Chipmunk Market. The entrance is next to the Office. The Lounge is a full-service bar where you can relax and enjoy the music of live bands. The Lounge is open to adults 21 years and over. Children are allowed in with their parents during special events, like Mother's Day Dance and Father's Day Dance.

A variety of live bands or DJ music is played every Saturday evening starting at 7PM. Band music styles include country, rock, and more. Complete band listing and other special events happening are listed in the rec schedule and in CampersAPP.

Activities like adult scavenger hunts, cook-offs, Texas Hold'em, and more happen throughout the summer.

The Hayloft Lounge hours are posted on the lounge door, on the back of the recreation schedule, and listed on the Lone Oak Park Channel 2.

Food and beverages are not allowed to be brought into or taken out of the Lounge. Shoes and shirts are required.

Pets

We do allow pets to camp along with you! T5, T6, and T7 are pet-friendly rental units. If you follow a few guidelines, your favorite companion can have a great time camping too!

- Pets must be on a leash at all times
- Do not leave pets on-site alone
- There is a pet walk area down by the Storage Area
- Please pick up after your pet while out for walks
- Pet Clean-up Bags are available for sale in the Chipmunk Market
- Pet Clean-Up stations are located around the campground and have waste bags for your dog
- Pets are not allowed in public buildings
- We require that you bring your pet's updated rabies certificate with you

Recreation Activities

Guests can find a hard copy of scheduled activities and updates for the weekend outside the Office. The schedule is also available on Lone Oak Park Channel 2, our website, and in CampersApp. During the summer months, weekday activities are also offered. Our recreation team members are always coming up with new and fun ideas for kids of all ages to enjoy. Recreation Hall

The Recreation Hall is located in the main building complex. Here, the entire family is treated to professional acts and DJs. Rec hall is open every day - check the schedule or park channel for hours. The rec hall is a non-smoking building. Check your rec schedule for Bingo days and times.

Located in the recreation hall are our pool tables, ping pong tables and video games. There is a change machine for video games. Video games are turned off during Bingo. Guests can rent ping pong paddles, pool cues, basketballs, and other sports equipment in the Office. A refundable security deposit is required until equipment is returned.

Game Fields & Courts

We have two horseshoe pits: next to Lori's Pond and in Spider's Web by the restrooms. Horseshoes can be obtained in the Office with your driver's license as a deposit. Licenses are returned to you upon return of the horseshoes. There may be a rental time limit during busier times.

The softball diamond is located down by the bridge. The soccer field is across the road from the softball field. We have multiple recreation fields. Rec Field #1 is located behind the main building. Across from the main building you will find Rec Field #2 (left side with picnic tables), Starlight Stage (middle), and Rec Field #3 (right side with a game field). There is a volleyball court and full basketball court, as well as other game fields. See a campground map on page 13-14 for locations.

Outdoor Movie Theater

From Memorial Day through Labor Day, movies are shown every Thursday, Friday, and Saturday night on our giant outdoor movie screen. The screen is located next to rec field #1, and movies start at dusk. The movie and their rating are posted on the rec schedule, park channel and movie board across from the Office.

Propane Tanks

For your family and our staff member's safety, separate disposable (1.0lb.) green propane cylinders from all other garbage. Do not place cylinders inside bags or boxes. Keep them out of the trash and recycling collection for staff to pick up and dispose of properly.

Refills

If you need a propane tank refilled, stop by the Office, they will contact a staff member to refill it for you.

Outdated Propane Tanks

Any propane tank under 100 lbs. has a date of manufature stamped into it. Tanks over 12 years old cannot be refilled unless recertified and given a new expiration date. We are not equipped to recertify tanks, however we have 20lb. and 30lb. propane tanks for sale that are purged and filled. Stop by the Office to purchase a new propane tank.

Fishing

The Blackberry River

The Blackberry River is located by the ball field and under the bridge into the campground. The state stocks fish in this river and a state fishing license is required for people ages 16 and older to fish.

Lori's Pond is Catch and Release Only

Lori's Pond is located next to the rec field and is stocked annually by Lone Oak with trout. We reserve this area for children 15 years and under (no license required).

Fishing License

You can purchase a fishing license at your town hall; at the local bait shop, Jim's Bait & Tackle, (860) 824-5773; or online. Go to www.ct.gov and choose 'Purchase a Hunting or Fishing License.'

Nightcrawlers are available for sale at the Chipmunk Market. There is also local fishing at Twin Lakes (approx. 15 minutes away). Pick up directions in the Office.

Golf Cart Rentals

Lone Oak offers the rental of eight 4-seat gas golf carts. Weekend reservations require a two-night minimum and a three-night minimum on a holiday. Reserve a golf cart by calling the Office or on our online reservation website. There is a \$50 reservation deposit to reserve a golf cart.

Prices do not include 6.35% Sales Tax. Gas is included.

Rental Golf Carts can be booked online

Rules for renting and operating a golf cart:

- 1. Lessee must be a minimum of 21 years old.
- All Operator(s) of Golf carts must be minimum 16
 years of age and have in their possession a valid
 drivers license. A copy of each operators drivers
 license is required at the office to rent a golf cart.
 Moped license, learner's permit, etc. are not acceptable.
- 3. Golf Carts operated after sunset must have lights turned on.
- 4. Golf Carts cannot be operated during quiet hours (11pm to 8am weekends, 10pm to 8am weekdays).
- 5. Golf Carts must be operated properly. Horseplay, racing, or other misuses of the cart will not be tolerated. Carts are to be operated on the blacktop, gravel roadways, and flat open fields only. No driving through campsites or other restricted areas. The speed limit is strictly enforced.
- 6. Golf Carts must remain on Lone Oak property at all times. Do not drive on or near Rt 44.
- Golf Carts must be returned at the designated time.
 Late returned carts will be charged \$10 for every hour late.
- 8. Golf Carts can carry a maximum of 4 people, and all passengers must be seated at all times when the golf cart is in motion.
- 9. Lost keys incur a \$20 charge.
- 10. Anyone found abusing the rules and regulations of rental golf carts will forfeit all rental privileges. There will be no refunds made if the cart has been returned or confiscated because of Lessee's misuse.
- 11. Lessee must present a valid credit card to be able to rent a golf cart.



General Information

Office

The Office is located in the main building complex. You can find local area & attraction brochures, local restaurant menus, and more! The Office is where you can ask any question, and we hope to help you the best we can.

Park Channels

Tune to Channel 2: for a variety of campground information. Channel 3: feature photos. Channel 4: Lone Oak's Weather. Cable T.V. is available on all sites that have electric hook up. Cable wires can be purchased in the Chipmunk Market.

P.A. System

Lone Oak has a public address system to keep you informed. Activities are announced throughout the campground during the day.

Gift Cards

Not sure what to get for someone who has everything? Try a Lone Oak Campsites Gift Card, available in all denominations. Gift Cards are available for purchase at the Office, Hayloft Lounge, or Store.



Lone Oak Loot

You will receive one Loot for every night you pay the regular rate. Loot will not be issued on discounted stays, like weekly or monthly stays. You will receive Loot upon check-in.

Save up six Lone Oak Loots, earn one night FREE during the off peak, or save ten Lone Oak Loots and stay two nights FREE during the off-time. This excludes rental units and discounted stays.

Campfires & Fire Rings

Fire rings are provided for each campsite. If your site does not have one, please call the Office and one will be delivered to your site. You can leave the fire ring at the campsite when you go.

Help protect our beautiful woods. Please do not cut down any trees or shrubs standing in our woods, whether dead or alive. Bundled firewood is available for purchase at the Chipmunk Market.



Our Water System

We have a state-approved water chlorination system, and you can expect the water pressure in the campground to be in a range of 45-65psi.

Laundry & Showers

We have two laundry facilities:

- 1) In the field area;
- 2) In Spider's Web.

There are change machines in the Field Laundry building and Rec Hall. Laundry Supplies are available in the main laundry building and the Chipmunk Market. Laundry washers and dryers use quarters to operate. A quarter provides 8 minutes of drying time.

Showers are located in most restrooms. Showers do require quarters to operate. With a quarter, a shower will last approximately 7½ minutes. Check the campground map for exact locations of facilities.



Bulletin Board

The bulletin board in front of the store is available to display 'For Sale' signs of used trailers & local services. Any information to be placed on the board needs to be approved at the Office.

Dump Station

Our dump station is located by the cottage at the top of the hill. There are two stations for your convenience. If you are camping with us, the dumping fee is free for the duration of your stay. There is a \$25 fee for dumping if you are not currently camping with us. Stop by the Office for details.

Online Reservations

We now have online reservations! Go to our website and click "Reserve Online" to reserve your campsite or golf cart at any time of the day or night.

Quiet Hours

Please respect the posted auiet hours:

Weekdays - 10pm to 8AM Weekends - 11pm to 8AM

Everyone should be at an occupied site by quiet hours. If you should have noisy neighbors, please report it to Security at 860-309-1012 or call the Office during operating hours at 800-422-2267. We want to ensure your camping experience is a pleasant one.

ATM

There is an ATM in the Chipmunk Market, available during the Market's operating hours.





Campground Rules

- Quiet hours: Sunday-Thursday 10PM-8AM, Friday & Saturday 11PM-8AM. Everyone must be at an occupied site. No outdoor music. Golf carts are to be used for necessary transportation only - no joy riding.
- Noise or activities that disturb other campers, regardless of the time of day are not allowed.
- 3. Visitors must register at the main gate or the office. All vehicles must have a clearly visible car pass when on Lone Oak property. Registered campers are responsible for their visitors. Visitors must leave by 11PM, or when registered camping family leaves.
- 4. Consumption of alcoholic beverages outside of your site must be from a cup, or the container must be covered with a koozie or similar. Please drink responsibly - public intoxication is not permitted. You must be 21 years or older to consume alcohol or to enter the Hayloft Lounge.
- 5. Children under 14 years old must have a parent or guardian within the campground property. Children ages 14-20 must have an adult responsible for them who is located within the campground property. No one under 21 years is allowed to camp without a parent or guardian.
- 6. No cutting through occupied sites.
- Check-in time: 3PM for campsites and rental units. Check-out time: 11AM for rental units, 2PM for campsites.
- Pets must be on a leash and under control. Do not leave pets on-site alone. There is a pet walk area down by the bridge. Please do not bring pets onto the ball field or rec fields. Clean up after your pet.

- Pets are not allowed in public buildings, in the pool area, or in the rental units (except T5, T6 and T7). You are required to have an up-to-date rabies certificate at your campsite.
- Bicycles/Scooters: Helmets must be worn by everyone, regardless of age. Must not be ridden in restricted areas, including rec hall, hallway, and patio in front of the office. Must be returned to your site by dusk.
- 10. No cutting trees dead or alive.
- 11. Fireworks, sky lanterns, and weapons are strictly prohibited, including CT legal fireworks.
- 12. Speed limit in the campground for all vehicles is 7MPH. Please go slower in congested areas. Obey all traffic and posted signs around the campground.
- 13. Golf carts: Must be registered with the office, and provide proof of liability insurance. May be driven only by a licensed driver. Passengers must be seated at all times. Must be driven responsibly and obey speed limits. May not be driven in restricted areas. No more passengers on a cart than seating allows. All carts must display your site number.
- 14. Please do not trespass on land bordering the campground, as it is private property.
- 15. Breaking of campground rules, charges of breaking any local, state, or federal law within the campground gives Lone Oak the right to immediately terminate or void any obligations or agreements it may have with the camping family.
- 16. We do not allow the use of ATVs, mini-bikes, gocarts, dirt bikes, or gasoline-powered scooters in the camparound.

Trash & Recycling

Recycling is easy when everyone works together, help us to help the environment. Clear plastic bags for garbage and blue plastic bags for recyclables are available at the office for your convenience. Every afternoon at approximately 3pm we will be picking up general garbage. You can also bring your trash to the trash and recycling bins located next to the maintenance building and in the T sites. On Thursdays and Sundays, we will pick up recycled items. Please help us by separating your garbage properly.

Bag #1 - General Garbage

Kitchen garbage, food, soiled paper, waxed paper, etc.

Bag #2 - Everything Else

Paper, Cans, Plastic, and Glass all in one bag

Cans, Plastic Bottles, and Glass

Rinse items (soup cans, pickle jars, etc.). Plastic bottles include any bottle with a 1 through 7 stamped on the bottom and contain a substance used to drink, eat, cook, clean, or wash.

Do not recycle bottles with pesticides, paints, toys, packaging products, or flower pots.

The Lone Oak Park Channels keep you updated on all campground activities, facility hours, photos, and other information. Cable is available on all sites with electric hook-ups. You can purchase cable wires in the Chipmunk Market. Channels subject to change.

Golf Cart Rules

Golf carts and unregistered motorized vehicles operated on Lone Oak Campsites property will be required to have personal liability insurance coverage. A copy of the Certificate of Liability insurance will be required to operate a golf cart or unregistered motor vehicle.

We ask that you register your golf cart/unregistered motor vehicle with the Office. The household members who will operate the golf cart must be listed and sign the registration form. Keep in mind that the permissible operators must possess a valid driver's license.

For proper identification, each golf cart and unregistered motor vehicle is required to be identified with their owner's name and site number. The letters and numbers should be at least 2 inches high or larger and placed in a visible location at all times.



Golf Cart Use Policy

- 1. Operators must hold a valid driver's license.
- 2. Golf Cart/motorized vehicles must not be operated under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- 3. Speed limits must be followed for the safety of pedestrians.
- 4. Golf carts used during the night must have working headlights and taillights.
- 5. Never leave the keys in the golf cart
- 6. There must not be more people riding in a golf cart than the actual seating capacity allows.
- 7. Golf cart/motorized vehicle must have proper muffler so as not to disturb other campers.
- 8. Golf carts must be registered with the Office, as well as permissible operators. Weekend campers should inform the office if they are bringing a golf cart, and will need to show proof of insurance.
- 9. Lone Oak Campsites requires verification of personal liability insurance (a Certificate of Liability) from the golf cart owner each season.
- 10. We do not allow the use of ATVs, mini-bikes, go-carts, dirt bikes, or motor scooters in the campground.
- 11. For consideration of others, do not drive golf carts in the S-Sites.



Storage

Trailer Storage

We offer short and long term storage in our fenced-in Storage Area at the entrance to the campground. Storage is available for daily, weekly, monthly, and 6-month rates. All trailers must be insured while storing with us. Contact the Office for pricing.

On-Site Storage

On-site storage is available on select sites Sunday-Thursday for \$5 per day, based on availability. Some restrictions apply: holidays and pull-thru sites excluded, five night storage maximum per month. Please note storage fees are not eligible for discounts.

Trailer Moving

We can move your trailer from our Storage Area to your campsite, from site to site, or from your site back to Storage. The fee is \$40 for 5th wheel trailers and \$30 for all other trailers for each move. You must sign up and make payment at the Office in advance. Moving times are generally scheduled during the week. Weekend moving must be arranged in advance.

If you are storing your trailer with us and want to move your trailer yourself, call us in advance of your arrival. We will place your trailer just outside of storage for you. There is no fee for this, as it is a service we provide to ensure each trailer's safety inside Storage. Please give us at least two days advance notice.

Winterizing

Winterizing is a necessary process to prepare a trailer for the winter. During the winterizing process, water is removed from the trailer and replaced by air and antifreeze.

Lone Oak offers a winterizing service in October. Stop by the Office for more information and to set up an appointment. We sell RV antifreeze in the Chipmunk Market if you would like to winterize your trailer yourself.

Camper Care

Lone Oak offers Camper Care, which closes your trailer in the fall and gets your trailer ready in the spring. This program includes checking all appliances on the initial startup. Camper Care does not include winterizing.

The Camper Care package includes turning off gas appliances and the gas tank, taking down slide-outs and jacks, and more for the winter. In the spring, it includes setting up slide-outs and jacks, turning on propane, testing propane and electric appliances, flushing antifreeze, and inspecting and reporting damages to the owner.
