## Changes To Your Campsite

Over the years campsites have been greatly improved. To insure that these changes conform to campground policy, we require all changes to your campsite have written approval from management.

## Sheds, Decks, Fences, and Awnings

If you plan to build a shed, deck, fence or awning, you must get your written dimensions approved at the office.

Sheds - We must limit the number of sheds on each site to one. Shed usage must be limited to storage only. Sheds are not to be used for sleeping quarters, and/or kitchenettes. Size limitations on sheds are; $8 \times 10$ by 8 feet high at peak. No metal sheds allowed.

Awnings - must be regular RV type.
Decks - Limitation on decks, 10 feet wide by the length of your trailer. Decks must be constructed in sections no larger than $8 \times 10$ feet and must be easily disassembled into $8 \times 10$ foot sections for moving purposes.

Fences - Must be made of wood. Finished side of fence material should face your neighbor. Fences should not be any closer than 10 feet from the edge of the road. Fences should not obstruct line of sight for the safety of pedestrians, bicycles and vehicles.
